"WOW! My brother is going to be so jealous!"

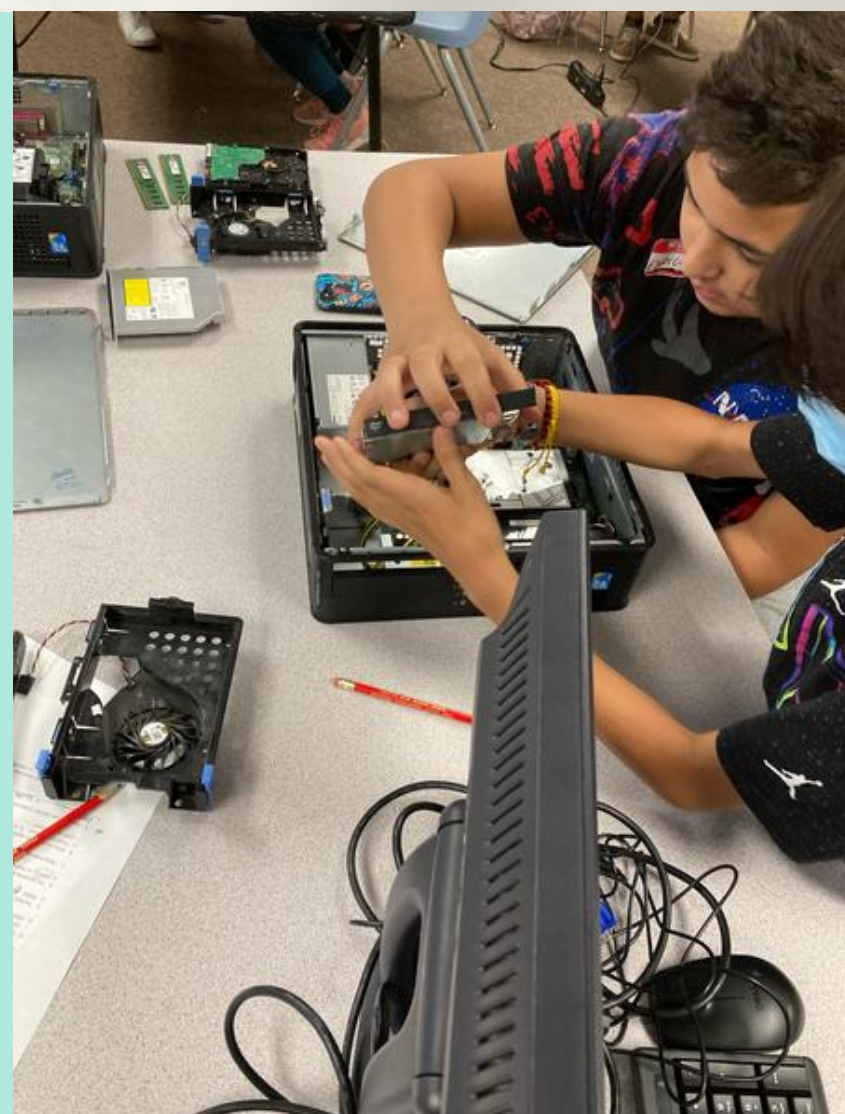
